Level awarded

Reasons why this level, and not the level above or below

- a lengthy and enjoyable letter
- the lack of technical accuracy, however, detracts from the overall quality
- connectives other than 'and' are present
- an appropriate greeting is evident along with a signing off and an attempt at the address and date
- some use of full stops but their use is erratic
- capital letters are used inconsistently
- spelling demonstrates a growing knowledge of whole word structure
- many monosyllabic words are spelled correctly but there are some inaccuracies e.g. 'whith', 'mite', 'their' and 'whant'
- some accurate polysyllabic spellings can be seen and Alex has made some good attempts at others
- the handwriting is clear -upper and lower case letters are not mixed within words
- this piece would reflect level 2A if the punctuation was of a good quality
